I hope you all had a peaceful holiday and a Happy New Year.

Your board of directors has been working diligently on your behalf; at the December 8, 2010 board meeting, several important revisions were implemented creating a positive impact on the organization.

I am pleased to announce that the directors unanimously approved changing the name of the academy to the American Board of Wound Management or ABWM (pending approval of trademark and other legal filings). This designation more appropriately defines our mission statement and progression over the last decade leading to more appropriate name recognition and uniformity with other specialties.

The board elected to retain the Exam and Finance committees as standing committees; other groups will be convened on an "ad hoc" basis or as tasks forces. You will be kept abreast of the needs of the organization as they arise; it is hoped that many of you will volunteer to participate in these endeavors. I am honored to report a milestone in the board's history; the formation of the ABWM FOUNDATION. Over time this body will be self sufficient and utilized to offer practice exams, evaluate exam review courses, offer educational events, etc. We will keep you informed as new details about this important body become available.

There are now 3280 certified multispecialty clinicians including CWS, CWCA, and CWSP designations under the AAWM "umbrella". Additionally, since Fall 2010, the board has bestowed 138 new CWS certifications.

Your organization is strong, solvent, and ready to serve. Use your wound certification proudly; in this environment of changing health care it is more important now than ever.

#### Happy New Year!

Congratulations to the 142 Certified Wound Care Associates (CWCA), 243 Certified Wound Specialists (CWS) and 22 Certified Wound Specialist Physicians (CWSP) that became certified in 2010. Your certification validates your commitment and dedication to competency assurance in wound care. The AAWM remains one of the most credible and prestigious certifying bodies in the wound care community.

As a reminder, your 2011 annual renewal was due January 31, 2011. The renewal invoices were mailed in November and again in December of 2010. *A \$50 late fee will be applied for all payments postmarked after January 31, 2011*. As part of the annual renewal you must demonstrate a minimum of six hours of continuing education in calendar year 2010 in the field of wound management. These hours can be achieved by attending live courses, participating on-line, or by any continuing education organization. The submission of continuing education units shall be made with the annual re-registration form and are subject to audit. If you have lost your renewal notice or have not received your renewal notice, please contact Ivey Wohlfeld (<u>iwohlfeld@aawm.org</u> or 202-457-8408) for a duplicate copy.

I know 10 years seems like a long time but if you obtained your CWS certification in 2001 it's time to take your 10-Year Re-Certification Exam. The Re-Certification Exam is offered in the same two week window as the regular CWS exam (April 16-30 and October 15-29). You will receive information (via U.S. Mail) regarding scheduling your re-certification exam about 3 months prior to your anniversary date.

As Dr. Snyder mentioned in the President's Report, a task-force has been assembled to establish a Foundation on behalf of AAWM. We will keep you informed on this exciting milestone as we finalize the plans and get closer to launching the AAWM's Foundation.

AAWM is pleased to announce the offering of the Certified Wound Care Associate (CWCA) practice test. Available online, at <u>https://secure.ptcny.com/webtest/clients/aawm/</u> the CWCA Practice Test is to be used for the purpose of self-assessment by those preparing to take the CWCA Board Certification Examination, or otherwise wanting to refresh their medical knowledge and skills. 
#### Some guidelines for writing questions:


- 1. They must be multiple-choice format.
- 2. They must have four possible answers (with the correct answer identified).
- 3. They must have a referenced source with each question.
- 4. They should be designed for participants to recall, understand, apply or evaluate.

AAWM is also looking to include case studies with photographs for future examinations. When submitting a photograph/digital image, the same question guidelines apply, as well as the following for photographs:

- 1. Photographs/digital images may be in either color or black/white (no Polaroids).
- 2. If using a digital camera, a high-resolution setting produces quality images.
- 3. The area of interest should be clear and easily identifiable.
- 4. Patient privacy must be respected; No names or identifying information may be visible.
- 5. If possible, a ruler (in cm or mm for scale purposes) should be visible in the photograph.

Please remember that all case studies and photographs/digital images become the property of the AAWM for use as determined by the AAWM. ## Dr. Murry Receives Designation of Certified Wound Specialist<sup>®</sup>

LANCASTER, OH – Andrew R. Murry, MD, CWS, FACP, an internist, infectious disease and wound care sub-specialist practicing in Lancaster, has received the designation of Certified Wound Specialist by the American Academy of Wound Specialists.

The distinction is the most prestigious and rigorous certification in wound care and demonstrates distinct and specialized expertise.

Murry was certified after demonstrating clinical experience in wound care over several years, obtaining letters of recommendation from other certified providers and passing a standardized test. Ongoing training and demonstration of knowledge are required to maintain this status.

He is part of a team of certified professionals inpatient and outpatient wound care in Lancaster.

# Marquette professor emeritus to teach seminar in Middle East

December 7, 2010 – Professor emeritus Luther Kloth retired seven years ago, but has had a hard time leaving his office at Marquette University.

In fact, he's expanded his teaching across the globe, teaching seminars in Japan, Europe and Colombia. The next stop? Kuwait.

Kloth, a prominent researcher and professor emeritus of physical therapy, will leave tomorrow for Kuwait to teach a four-day seminar on wound care, including pressure ulcers (aka bedsores), venous and arterial insufficiency ulcers, and diabetic foot ulcers.

The trip comes after a couple years of planning with a Kuwaiti physical therapist who attended two of his wound healing seminars in the U.S.

Although Kloth has been to the middle east on vacation, he has never been to Kuwait and said he is looking forward to learning about medical practice and cultural impacts on the practice.

"What I want to do is teach this course and help the learners go back into their work settings and put it into practice," Kloth said.

Kloth will be teaching 30 doctors and nurses from Kuwait and Dubai.

The online practice test is provided for educational purposes only, to assist you in identifying areas of relative strength and weakness in the content areas that are assessed by the CWCA Board Certification Examinations. While it is constructed to be similar to those exams, the online practice test is not intended to, and should not be used to try to, predict your performance on the CWCA Board Certification Examination.

It is not necessary for you to take the Online Practice Test prior to taking the CWCA Board Certification Examination. There are other review courses, and other methods of preparation available, and you should make an independent determination of which method would be most helpful.

After completing the online practice test, you will receive an instant score report showing test performance in each of the content areas.

A practice test for the Certified Wound Specialist<sup>®</sup> (CWS<sup>®</sup>) will be available in early March.



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


